Third parties

Cookies

Aldebaran Commodities B.V. does not use cookies or similar techniques.

See, modify or delete data

You have the right to see your personal information, to correct or remove it. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your permission, or to object to the processing of your personal data and you have the right to data portability. That means that you can submit a request to send the personal data that we have to you or another organization, you mentioned. To ensure that the request for inspection is done by you, we ask you to include a copy of your photo ID with the request.

Make a copy of your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the Strip with numbers at the bottom of the Passport), passport number and social security number black. This to protect your privacy. We respond as quickly as possible, but within four weeks, at your request.
