Alabama: 93% Peanuts planted. Mornroe County, 'peanuts that were planted look good'.

**Florida:** Peanut pegging was slightly ahead of the previous year and the 5-year average.

**Georgia:** Mitchell County, peanuts are now growing well.

North Carolina: The state received widespread rainfall. Peanuts pegging at 30%.

**Oklahoma:** Peanut condition was rated 93 percent good to fair, 89 percent had of the crop had emerged and 13 percent was pegging by Sunday.

South Carolina: The State average rainfall for the seven-day period was 0.2 inches. Peanuts pegging at 48%.

**Texas:** Peanuts made good progress in the Southern High Plains.

**Virginia:** Virginia received some scattered showers towards the end of the week, which brought relief to the planted crops. For the parts of Virginia that missed the recent rainstorms, dry conditions were a concern. Surry County, 'peanuts are growing well'.

**Alabama:** Precipitation estimates for the state ranged from 0.80 inches to 3.55 inches of rain. Planting continues. Henry County, producers are almost finished planting peanuts.

**Florida:** Planting of peanuts continued in the Panhandle and north Florida this past week as weather permitted.

**Georgia:** Precipitation estimates for the state ranged from 0.1 inches of rain up to 2.4 inches. Peanut condition reported 3% poor, 32% fair, 54% good and 11% excellent.

North Carolina: Peanut planting complete. Peanut condition reported 1% poor, 19% fair, 70% good and 10% excellent.

**Oklahoma:** Peanut conditions were rated 98 percent good to fair, seedbed preparation reached 89 percent complete. Peanuts planted and emerged reached 84 and 66 percent complete, respectively, by Sunday.

South Carolina: Peanut planting complete.

**Texas:** Peanut planting continued in areas of South Texas. Peanut condition reported 8% excellent, 44% good, 34% fair, 13% poor and 1% very poor.

Virginia: Peanut planting continues. Peanut condition reported 1% fair, 91% good and 8% excellent.

**Alabama:** Henry County, peanut planting approx. 85% complete. Monroe County received more rain this past week further hindering peanut planting.

Florida: Planting of peanuts continued as weather permitted.

**Georgia:** Precipitation estimates for the state ranged from .2 inches of rain up to 3.0 inches. Peanut crop conditions reported 3% poor, 35% fair, 53% good and 9% excellent.

North Carolina: Peanut crop condition falls within the fair and good ratings.

**Oklahoma:** Warm weather continued and all nine districts received measurable rainfall last week. Peanut seedbed preparation reached 88 percent complete with 59% emerged.

**South Carolina:** The State average rainfall for the seven-day period was 1.2 inches. Routine disease controls are being applied to peanuts.

**Texas:** Peanut planting progressed in the Upper Coast.

Virginia: It was a good week for fieldwork. Peanut crop condition reported 89% good.
